

5. Report of the event




Mr. Subhash S. Pawar, employee of Department of NSS, North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon gave a lecture on Competitive Examination On 28/12/17 at 3.00 pm in the afternoon session after lunch. Mr. Subhash. S Pawar gave very enthusiastic and enlightening guidance on competitive examination to the NSS Volunteers. He discussed the various types of competitive examinations (UPSC, MPSC, Railways and Banking etc.), the means of study for them, the available opportunities, the various competitive examination guidance centers, the schemes of the Government of Maharashtra and the Central Government regarding competitive examinations, etc.

He focused that the aspirants for Competitive Examination must be with one goal to achieve. The examination is divided into three stages 1] Preliminary - Examination that is Multiple Choice Question used as the testing of general knowledge of the examinees. 2] Main Examination- varies in case of MPSC and UPSC as well as the posts are concerned. The number of papers are also varies according to the posts. 3] Third step is depending on the Communication skills and overall knowledge of concerned examination in the context of reality of the administrative posts. Those who have qualified the main examination are called for oral interview.

The students who have to desire to appear for Examination and qualify it. They must be very careful about their study and time management. 110 NSS Volunteers benefited by this guidance. Thus, the programme ended in questions and answers of speaker
